

BEFORE YOU START!


- All on-screen instructions MUST be followed. Straying from the on-screen instructions could cause damage to the machine and the user.
- · Always check that wires and tubes are clear before fitting The Stinger or Pad Head. Failure to do so could cause machine damage.
- The Stinger and Pad Head should be stored in their foam case. To prevent loss or damage always store The Stinger and Pad Head in their case as soon as they are removed.
- Do NOT twist or rotate any connectors. This will cause damage to both the ROTOR+ and The Stinger.
- Take care when removing The Stinger or Pad Head. The magnets are very strong do not let The Stinger of Pad Head collide with the ROTOR+.
- Pull all connectors by their plugs only. NEVER pull connectors by the cables or damage will occur.
- · Always pinch down the white ring on the pneumatic connectors when removing. The white ring locks the connector in place, trying to remove without unlocking will cause connection damage.
- Ensure black connectors are orientated correctly. The black connectors have locators that need to be align before inserted. Misalignment will cause damage.
- During head removal, always ensure the push cylinder is cleared before moving away from the carriage. The push cylinder runs from the carriage arm into The Stinger/Pad Head. If either are not pulled down far enough during removal, the cylinder will catch and damage the ROTOR+.
- Ensure the unused connector is securely in the holder before operating the ROTOR+. A loose cable may cause machine damage.
- · Always ensure the power is OFF before changing heads. Leaving the power on cau sea a hardware crash.
- Ensure The Stinger's pin cartridge is pushed to back left corner of ROTOR+ pad rim. This is to avoid damage to the pad rim's locator pins.




INTRODUCTION

The Stinger is an accessory for the ROTOR+ which enables individual colony manipulation by using one pin at a time. It allows colonies of interest to be cherry-picked from one (or multiple) source plate(s) to one (or multiple) target plate(s) on agar or in liquid medium. Programs may be compiled by file upload or by manual operation.




· Once the carriage arm has moved into position, turn power off ROTOR+ by pressing the *Red Stop Button*.




· Insert the *Pad Head Foam Case* into the *Black Bay Zone*.



· Remove the Black Bay from the ROTOR+






· Insert *The Stinger* with it's protective foam case into the *Black Bay Zone*.






· Pull down gently on the *Pad Head* with both hands until it comes free from the *Magnetic Carriage Arm*. Remember to grip the pad head firmly.




Remove *The Stinger Data Contact Cable* from the holder on the carriage arm and replace it with the *Pad Head Gripper Contact Cable*.




• Connect *The Stinger* to the *Carriage Arm* by lifting it up until it snaps into place. The cylinder arm should be on the right hand side when facing the ROTOR+ (as shown).




· Connect the *Pneumatic Line* to *The Stinger Head* by gently inserting it into the *Pneumatic Socket*




· Insert The Stinger Data Cable into Data Socket.



· Remove the *Stinger Foam Case* from the *Black Bay Zone*.




· Re-insert the *Black Bay.*

- · Initialise the ROTOR+.




· Connect the *Pneumatic Line* to the *Pad Head* by gently inserting it into the *Pneumatic Socket*.




· Insert the Pad Head Gripper Contact Cable into the Contact Cable Socket.




· Remove the *Pad Head Foam Case* from the *Black Bay Zone*.




· Re-insert the Black Bay.




- · Turn the *Red Stop Button* clockwise until it pops out.
- · Initialise the ROTOR+.




· After using The Stinger, remove *Dump Drawer* from the ROTOR+.




· Load the *Used Pins* into the empty *Pin Cartridge*.



· Secure the *Cartridge Cover* to the full Pin Cartridge using the two *Cartridge Screws*.




· Remove the *Bottom Tray Cartridge* to enable access to the points of the used pins.



· Scrub the exposed *Pin Tips* with a 70% ethanol solution to clean, then rinse.

· Remove the *Cartridge Cover* and leave to dry.




· Autoclave all parts of the *Cartridge*. Keep the pins in the cartridge but leave off the *Bottom Tray* and for optimum sterilisation.

· On the ROTOR+ home screen you will be asked to select an operation mode. Select the *Run Stinger* option.





On the Run Stinger Screen, select the *Import Spreadsheet* option.






· While the ROTOR+ is running you can pause/ resume or abort the program at any time.

- · When the program has finished a summary is displayed.
- · After clicking OK, follow the on-screen instructions to remove the plates.



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SELECTING MANUAL MODE

1.

· As well as using .CSV files to run The Stinger, you can also pin plates manually.

On the Stinger menu, choose *Select Stinger Colonies*.

• This is the manual mode screen. Here you can manually control the Stinger in real time. There are 5 groups of commands:

Move to - Select where the Stinger should move.


Pin - Pin in the Stinger's current location.

Table - Rotate the turntable to access other plates.

Lids - Remove or replace all or specific plate lids.

Pins - Pick up or dump pins.

- Click through these options to build your desired routine. The ROTOR+ will perform these options as you go.
- · NOTE: Only possible options are displayed. E.g. You can't dump a pin if the Stinger isn't holding a pin.


· Click a coloured plate bay and select your plate details.

· Remember:


Source is the plate that contains the colonies you want to nick

Target is the plate you want to pin the colonies on.

· Load your plates into the ROTOR+'s colour-coded bays and then click *Rotate* to prepare them for pinning.




SELECTING MANUAL MODE



1.96-Density

- · While the Stinger is over a 96-density plate, after selecting *Pin*, a grid of the chosen plate will be displayed. This example shows a 96-density plate.
- Use the column/row drop down menu to select the colony location you want to pin. Or simply press the colony location on the plate diagram.
- · In this example we have selected location D4.
- · Click OK to pin.




2. 1536-density

• To help with readability on screen, when selecting colonies on a 1536-density plate, locations are split into groups of 16.




• Use the column/row drop down menu to select the exact colony location or click a range in the diagram to zoom in on those 16 locations.


- · After clicking a location range, click on a specific location to select a colony for picking.
- · In this example we have selected Q29.
- The pinning history of the selected colony is displayed on the right.
- · Select *OK* to pin.



MANUALLY SELECTING COLONY LOCATIONS


4. Lawn / Bath

- When selecting a lawn plate to pin, there is no grid view. Instead the colony locations are based on X/Y locations.
- Select the location of your colony on the plate using the touch screen, or type the X & Y locations.
- · Previously pinned locations are listed on the right and also marked with crosses on the plate.
- The screen is currently in *Coarse Mode*. For more precise control, select *Switch To Fine*.



5.

- · After selecting *Switch To Fine* the screen zooms in on your current location. Selecting *Live Preview* will move The Stinger as you move on screen.
- · To zoom out select Switch To Coarse.
- \cdot If the colony is correctly located, select \emph{OK} to pin.
